We hope everyone has had a happy, healthy, and safe summer. We are very excited to be welcoming our students back to campus for the 2021-2022 school year. Here are some important points we think our community needs to know before the **first day of school on Aug. 17, 2021**. Some of this information has just recently been updated so please read carefully.

- **The doors to St. Elmo will now open at 7:30am every morning.**
 - This is a change to what has been communicated at the Meet the Principal events and we are making it to ensure the health and safety of our students.
 - Students will enter the building at 7:30am and proceed straight to class. We appreciate your support and understanding as we do everything we can to keep our community healthy.
 - IF YOU HAVE AN URGENT NEED TO HAVE YOUR STUDENT AT SCHOOL BEFORE 7:30AM, PLEASE FILL OUT [THIS GOOGLE FORM](#).
 - Students are late after 7:45am
 - Call us at 512-414-4477 with any questions
- **Masks are required for all students and staff inside any AISD building**
 - Please let us know in the morning if your child needs a mask
 - Everyone will be required to wear a mask throughout the entire school day
 - This is per CDC guidance and we are grateful to our Superintendent for making this happen
- **The dismissal process has changed for the afternoon**
 - All students (PK included) will be dismissed at 3:10pm
 - PK-2 grade students will be dismissed from the front of the school.
 - Grades 3-5 students will be dismissed from the big parking lot. Please drive as far as you can in one line between the parked cars.
NOTE: If you have a child in both categories, you should use the entrance for the eldest child. (EX: If you have a 1st grader and a 4th grader, go through the 4th grade pick up, the big parking lot. All your children will be at the pick-up spot of the eldest child)
- **Meet the Teacher Night is Monday, August 16, from 4pm-6pm**
 - This is an informal event where families should plan to be in the building no longer than 10 minutes.
 - You will walk straight into the building, where there will be people telling you which class and teacher to go to.
 - Please walk straight to that classroom, drop off supplies (if you have them), say hello to your teacher, and then leave the building.
